**MORNING FOODS RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS RAISED DURING MATTER 4 HEARING SESSION FOR THE CHESHIRE EAST COUNCIL SITE ALLOCATION DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT EXAMINATION**

At the recent Hearing Session for the Cheshire East Council Site Allocation Development Plan Document Examination in relation to Matter 4, Employment and Economy, it was requested that Morning Foods provide a note on the job numbers that would be created as a result of future development at site CRE 2: Land at Gresty Road, Crewe.

Morning Foods have ambitious plans for the site, and with its inclusion in the Site Allocation Development Plan Document, the site CRE 2 would be developed to provide storage and distribution services associated with Morning Foods' existing facilities and would generate in the region of 50 – 60 jobs. In addition, there would be significant job creation through the construction period, both directly at the site, and indirectly through spinoff jobs created in the local construction industry and additional spending on local services and facilities.
